- 1. As per the suggestion of the students, the Electoral Literacy Club of the college has conducted Some Voting Awareness Programme.
- 2. As per the suggestion of the students, some Student development programmes like IMPRINT, 7 days online Personality Development Certificate Course, *UDAAN*, a 7 days inter-collegiate competition, *Probodhan* a five days to student development programme comprising of five different lecture series was conducted for the Skill development of the student.

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
