

09/04/2022

With the view of inculcating moral values in the mind of the students and making them socially aware of the difficulties and hardship of the society, the Social Awareness Cell of IQAC organized one day webinar on "Domestic Violence and Pre-Wedding Counselling" was conducted. Registration of the students was done through Google Forms. Advocate Poonam Soni was the invited as resource person to deliver topic on "Domestic Violence and Pre-Wedding Counselling" Dr. Usha Sakure, Principal of the college gave her opening remarks. In her opening remarks, she said that Domestic violence abusers are not only a risk to their partners and family but also their community. While law enforcement officers are at an especially high risk of harm, violence wrought by abusers can also lead to injury or death of everyday bystanders. She urged that Social justice is needed in term of policies of action that are consistent with the preservation of human dignity and the showing of equal respect for the interests of all members of the community. Advocate Poonam Sony in her insightful presentation focused on various aspects of domestic violence that include scratching, pushing, shoving, grabbing, biting, choking, shaking, slapping, punching, hitting, burning, use of a weapon, and use of restraint or one's body against another person. She also highlighted on the issues of Emotional abuse that include non-physical behaviors that are meant to control, isolate, or frighten the person. She came up with the suggestion that in the new wedding culture wher pre-wedding shoots are encouraged, there is a need of pre-wedding counselling for the healthy relationship between the spouse. She gave helpline numbers for combating the domestic violence. She gave information about the constitutional rights and Domestic Violence Act, 2005 that deal with the problem of domestic violence. The webinar was interactive and well received by the students. All the teaching, non-teaching staff and students participated in the webinar. Dr. Meenakshi Wasnik compered the webinar and proposed the vote of thanks.


